2024 Greece and Turkey Trip Sept 18-Oct 6

About the trip:

Join us as we walk in the footsteps of Paul and also visit the churches of Revelation. See the New Testament come to life as you listen to bible lectures delivered in the places it was written (in some cases, on the very spot it took place!). For 17 days, you will be guided through some of the major cities of the New Testament, including: Ephesus, Laodicea, Hierapolis, Pergamum, Philippi, Thessalonica, Corinth, and Athens. You will also get to tick off bucket-list items as we visit places like Gallipoli, Troy, the white cliffs of Pumakkale (Google it), and the monasteries of Meteora (again, Google it). This is guaranteed to be a life-changing experience that you do not want to miss.

About the Lecturer:

Adam White is an associate professor of New Testament at Alphacrucis College. He has spent more than a decade studying and writing about the world of Paul and the New Testament and has also led numerous tours to Greece and Turkey. Adam will bring the New Testament to life as you visit the very cities in which Paul himself first preached.

Itinerary:

- Day 1 (Sept 18): arrive in Istanbul and fly to Izmir to stay for the night.
- Day 2 (Sept 19): visit Sardis (Rev 1:11; 3:1–4) and then overnight in Colossae Thermal.
- Day 3 (sept 20): visit Laodicea (Rev 1:11; 3:14), Hierapolis (Col. 4:13), then spend the afternoon enjoying the natural spring water of Pumakkale and the Cleopatra Pools; overnight again in Colossae Thermal.
- Day 4 (Sept 21): visit Aphrodisias and then overnight in Marina Suites, Kusadasi.
- Day 5 (Sept 22): visit Ephesus and then overnight in Marina Suites, Kusadasi.
- Day 6 (Sept 23): visit Pergamum (Rev. 1:11; 2:12) and then overnight in La Bella Hotel, Pergamum.
- Day 7 (Sept 24): visit the ancient city of Troy and then overnight in Buyuk Truva, Canakkale.
- Day 8 (Sept 25): visit Gallipoli battle site then overnight in Buyuk Truva, Canakkale.
- Day 9 (Sept 26): border crossing to Greece and overnight Hotel Galaxy, Kavala.
- Day 10 (Sept 27): visit Philippi then overnight Hotel Capsis, Thessaloniki.
- Day 11 (Sept 28): visit Mt Olympus and then overnight Hotel Orfeas, Kalambaka.
- Day 12 (Sept 29): visit Meteora Monasteries then overnight at Hotel Acropole, Delphi.
- Day 13 (Sept 30): visit Delphi then overnight at Hotel Parthenon, Athens.
- Day 14 (Oct 1): explore Athens then overnight at Hotel Parthenon, Athens.
- Day 15 (Oct 2): explore Athens then overnight at Hotel Parthenon, Athens.
- Day 16 (Oct 3): visit Corinth then overnight at Tolon Holidays, Tolo.
- Day 17 (Oct 4): visit Mycenae and Epidaurus then overnight at Tolon Holidays, Tolo.
- Day 18 (Oct 5): visit Isthmia and Nemea then overnight at Hotel Parthenon, Athens.
- Day 19 (Oct 6): Depart Athens for home.
