Why is a Christian University so Important?

AC strives to fulfil the following mission and vision:

MISSION

Equipping Christian leaders to change the world.

VISION

A global Christian university, transforming neighbourhoods and nations.

Universities exert a powerful influence on culture and society. Alphacrucis University College, uniquely positioned in Australasia because of its Christian values and Pentecostal heritage, produces leaders who influence the social, political, and economic landscape of our region and across the nations. During our 75th anniversary we celebrate thousands of graduates who take the challenge of their calling and vocation for impactful Christian ministry. We are raising Christian leaders from vocational programs in schools and churches, transforming Christian leaders across bachelor and postgraduate sectors, and growing the impact of Christian leadership through research and innovative programs in leadership, education, business, theology, counselling, and social sciences. Although our enrolment policy does not require students to be Christian, all students are provided with the opportunity to encounter Christ in a learning environment committed to the integration of faith and learning.

“The “central educational mission of the university should be to teach students, not just to understand the world and achieve their goals in it, but to make wise judgement about what those goals should be and how to pursue them in intellectually and morally responsible ways” (Miroslav Volf)*.

Australia currently has 42 universities which exert a powerful influence on culture, society, and government policy as they educate and train leaders. Surveys indicate that 52% of first-year Christian university students no longer identify as Christian when they graduate.** The majority of these universities influence students towards secular humanism which marginalises the Christianity and its values. A university education that does not include an appreciation of the relationship between Creator and creation provides an inadequate foundation for what it means to be human.

A university based on Christian worldview and values challenges the voices of secular humanism and similar ideologies. This integration of faith and learning has a positive effect on a student’s “values, choices, decision making, and ethics.”***

Christianity is a public faith that seeks to benefit society. A significant component of the church’s influence on society is its involvement in health, education, well-being, and justice. A Christian university brings faith back into the public sphere and counters the prevailing intolerance towards Christian ethos, the church, and the value of religion to our nation. Faith in the public sphere speaks to matters of conscience, liberty, freedom, mercy, and justice. AC integrates faith with learning to produce graduates who are better equipped to influence our local communities, our nation, and globally, and provide innovative and practical support to individuals and communities.

Finally, a significant number of Australian families enrol their children in Christian schools because they wish to have values incorporated into their children’s education. It is likely that these same families value the opportunity to continue their children’s Christian value-based education at tertiary level. Australia needs Christian universities to help transform our nation and to bring life-affirming support for our people.

2023 DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD

Glyn and Sophia Barrett

The Council of Alphacrucis University College (AC) is pleased to announce Glyn and Sophia Barrett as joint recipients of the AC Distinguished Alumni Award for 2023 and congratulate them on this recognition. The Distinguished Alumni Award, nominated by peers and fellow alumni, recognises and encourages alumni who are outstanding leaders in their vocation and community, who exemplify the AC Graduate Attributes, have made significant contributions to the Christian church, their vocations, and community, and who have demonstrated continued interest in and contribution to AC.

Born in Manchester, Glyn and his family moved to Australia when he was two years old. He has served the Lord since childhood and his strong faith comes from being raised in a Christian home by church ministers who were Bible teachers as well as pastors. Growing up in this environment influenced Glyn's decision to study theology at AC, and it was during this season of his life that he met and married Sophia, who also studied and graduated from AC in 1995. By 1996, Glyn and Sophia moved back to England to pioneer a youth and young adults ministry at Hope City Church in Sheffield. By 2007 they were embarking on the journey of building the highly successful !Audacious Church in the heart of Manchester.

!Audacious Church has grown from 50 people in a back street warehouse to a multi-site, multi-generational church in 4 locations, with the Central Manchester location having an active congregation of 4000 people. In addition to the church, Glyn and Sophia worked to establish the !Audacious Foundation, which exists to support many community projects and feed thousands of people throughout Manchester and the Midlands who are either homeless or in need of extra care and support. Such a contribution to the Christian church and their community is worthy of recognition.

In 2019, Glyn was appointed as the national leader of the Assemblies of God within the UK. Along with his national team, he now oversees more than 500 churches across Great Britain and is committed to seeing each one of them thrive and make an impact within their communities. Sophia speaks across the globe at different conferences and events, where her messages communicate powerful truths from the word of God in her own unique style. In 2016, Sophia wrote her first book entitled STAY in which she shares her journey of chronic sleeplessness and the power of being mindful of God and learning to 'stay' in his presence. To coincide with the book launch she also filmed her first television show for TBN as well as released two meditation albums, STAY and REMAIN.

Together, Glyn and Sophia have turned their experience at AC into the formation of the AOG GB's Leadership Development, Church Planting, Church Health, and Missions ministries. Glyn has also continued his studies with AC, recognising the value of ongoing growth and personal development, and will graduate with a Master of Leadership from AC this year. While they have accomplished many things, two of their greatest achievements are their children Georgia and Jaedon. The deep love that Glyn and Sophia have for their family, friends and community is what motivates them to continue the work of furthering the Kingdom of God around the world.



2023 HONORARY DOCTORATE

Andrew Evans

The purpose of an Honorary Doctorate from Alphacrucis University College (AC) is to recognise an individual who has achieved eminence in an area of education or research, or is distinguished by eminent service to the community. These achievements must be well beyond the usual expectations of the nominee's usual role and responsibility. Andrew Evans OAM is being awarded an Honorary Doctor of Ministry (HonDMin) for his eminent contribution nationally and globally toward religious, cultural, and social leadership in the areas of church ministry and community service.

Throughout the course of his life, Andrew Evans has modelled and embodied a strong Christian worldview. His ministry began in 1958-1960 when he studied at Commonwealth Bible College. Upon graduating, Andrew and his wife Lorraine pastored at Flinders Park and Elizabeth before serving as missionaries with Australian AOG World Missions in the East Sepik Province of Papua New Guinea. Evans returned to Australia in 1970 to take on the position of Senior Pastor at Klemzig AOG (later renamed Paradise Community Church).

Andrew Evans was Senior Pastor of Paradise Community Church for 30 years (1970–2000). His leadership, which has always been characterized by growth, saw the church grow from 200 to over 4,000 people. Paradise also planted Southside Christian Church (later known as Edge Church) in 1994. Evans' contribution to community and religious service was recognised in 2003 when he was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia for his service to the Christian Church.

Andrew Evans served as General Superintendent of the Assemblies of God in Australia for 20 years (1977-1997) and also served on the World AOG Executive. Under his leadership, the AOG in Australia experienced great growth, multiplying by over 13 times in number of members and

planting over 700 churches. One of Evans' most famous contributions to the history of the Assemblies of God in Australia was his conciliatory skills after his induction as General Superintendent in 1977. When the movement was in danger of fragmenting, his outstanding personal and social skills nurtured the continuing unity and growth of the movement.

Andrew Evans has also made an outstanding contribution to Australian politics through founding the Family First party in South Australia in 2001. He was elected in the 2002 State Election and served until his retirement in 2008. Some significant contributions during his time in politics include:

- i. Introduced the Bill that abolished the bar to prosecuting people for sexual offences committed before 1 December 1982.
- ii. Introduced the motion that established the Select Committee into the Status of Fathers in South Australia.
- iii. Compelled the State Labor Government to include an interim 2020 target for its climate change legislation.

Andrew Evans is an inspirational communicator, as evidenced by his religious, political, and social leadership at a national level. Through his preaching and leadership, he has had a profound influence on the shaping of Pentecostal theology and ecclesiology in Australia. His contribution to Australian politics, particularly in South Australia, has also left a positive and lasting legacy. Andrew Evans has made a significant contribution to the spread of the Gospel, and to the health and strength of Christian communities, both in Australia and around the world.
